
## Services available to qualified veterans and their families include:

- Rental and Utility Assistance
- · Landlord Mediation
- Case Management Services for Long-Term Housing Stability
- Transportation Assistance
- Emergency Hotel Stays, honoring social distancing guidelines if required

## **Qualifications:**

- 1. Any Veteran who has served at least 24 hours of active duty and has any discharge status other than Dishonorable.
- The Veteran family is considered low-income, defined as earning 50% or less of the Area Median Income. Determination of income status can be found at https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/il.html.
- 3. Veterans or Veteran Families must be either currently legitimately homeless or are in imminent danger of facing homelessness.
